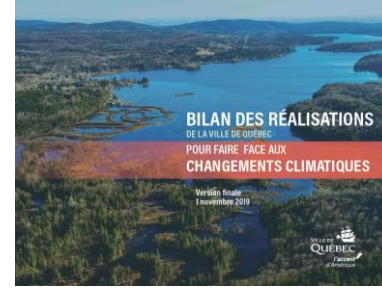

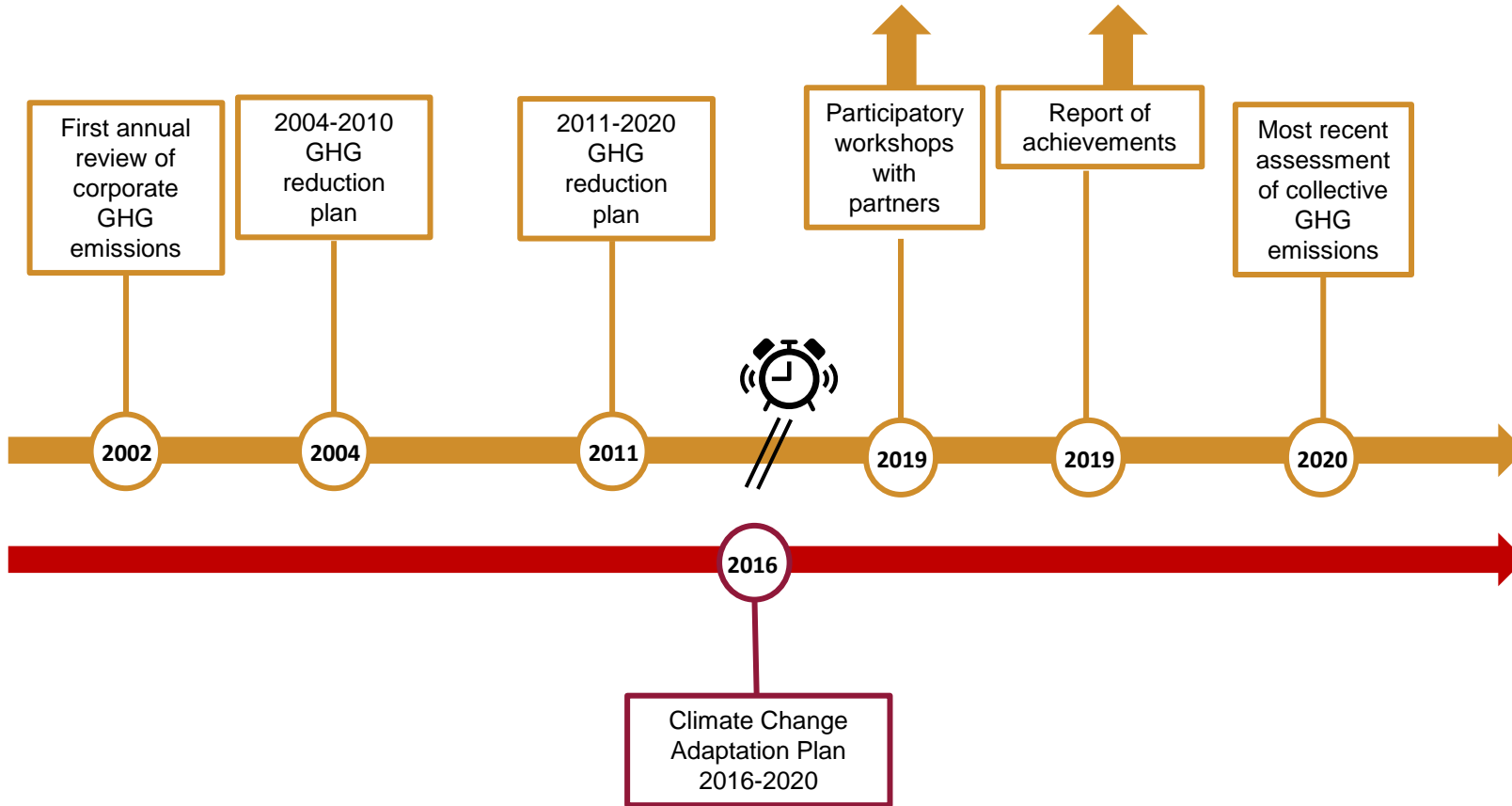
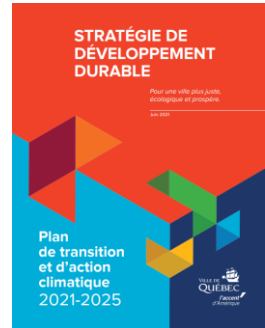
A brief history

- Engagement from elected officials and city administration



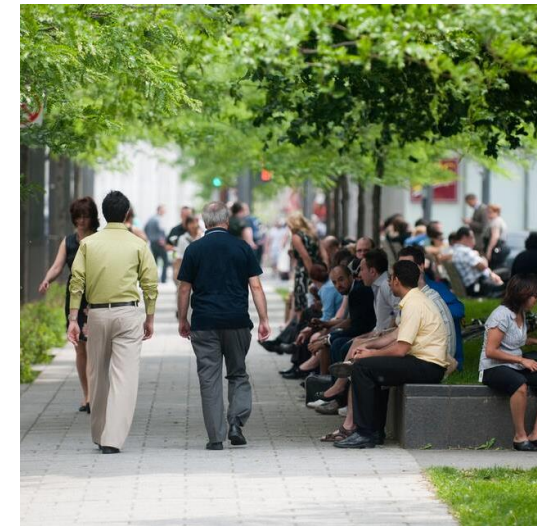
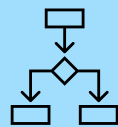

Active mobility



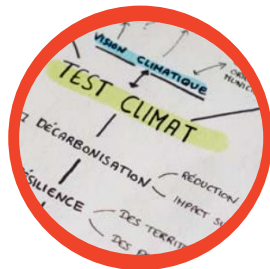
Our mayor announced the new plan for active mobility last week
